BEST EVER LEMONADE

INGREDIENTS:

1 CUP SUGAR 1 CUP LEMON JUICE (4-6 LEMONS) COLD WATER



The secret to great lemonade is twofold:

A. a simple syrup

B. a little zest

- Heat 1 cup of water and 1 cup of sugar in a small saucepan to simmer.
 Simmer and stir until all sugar is dissolved.
- Add grated lemon zest (1-2 lemons to taste) to your syrup. Remove from heat
- While syrup is simmering, juice lemons to get 1 cup of lemon juice.
- Add zesty syrup and lemon juice to your serving/storage pitcher. Add Cold Water to taste (3 to 6 cups).

Remember ice will also water down your lemonade, so adjust accordingly.

Feel free to make it your own: add mint, hint of OJ or lime juice, mix with clear soda, soda water, or favorite adult beverage. Add more lemon for a tarter

Another option is to take lemon peels and soak in cool water over night, use this instead of cold water and lemon zest when mixing.
